1 Day **Dirang**
Arrival – Guwahati to Dirang

2 Day **Dirang**

Upon arrival, check in to your hotel or homestay and take some time to relax. In the evening, enjoy a relaxed local tour of Tawang town, visiting the vibrant market, peaceful monasteries, or simply strolling through the chilly mountain air. End your day with a warm dinner and an overnight stay in Tawang, preparing for the adventures ahead.

4 Day **Tawang**
Tawang Sightseeing – Bumla Pass, Madhuri Lake & High-Altitude Wonders

After an early breakfast, begin your full-day excursion to the breathtaking high-altitude frontier areas of Tawang. Your journey starts with a drive toward the legendary Bumla Pass, located right at the Indo-China border. The route itself is an experience, snow-covered landscapes, frozen streams, rugged mountain cliffs, and endless stretches of white make it feel like a different world. At Bumla Pass, you can enjoy the surreal snow experience, walk around designated zones, interact with the soldiers (when permitted), and witness the incredible landscape where clouds seem to touch the ground.

From here, continue to the enchanting Madhuri Lake (Shonga-tser Lake), famous for its cinematic beauty and named after actress Madhuri Dixit from the Bollywood film Koyla. Surrounded by towering snow-capped mountains and scattered tree trunks emerging from its blue waters, the lake offers a perfect backdrop for photography and quiet reflection. Enjoy the peaceful ambience, sip a cup of hot tea at the army café nearby, and take in the calmness of this pristine Himalayan gem.

You may also visit other scenic spots along the route, such as PTSO Lake, which often appears partially frozen and mirrors the surrounding peaks beautifully. After completing your sightseeing, drive back to Tawang town by late afternoon. Spend the evening strolling through the local market or relaxing at your stay.
