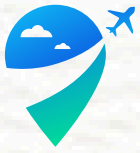

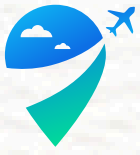

DAY 1: **DELHI to MANALI**

- All participants must reach ISBT kashmere gate by 07:00 PM in Delhi. You should reach this location on your own; from there, our adventure to Manali will commence.
- Our team will provide all necessary information to assist you in finding the Volvo boarding point, where our bus will be waiting.
- After everyone has checked into the Volvo bus, we will begin our overnight journey to Manali.





DAY 2:

MANALI EXPLORATION

- In the early morning, you will arrive in Manali, and from there, you'll need to make your way to the hotel.
- After checking into the hotel, you can take some time to rest or explore nearby attractions in Manali, such as Mall Road and Hadimba Devi Temple.
- In the evening, there will be a briefing session at 7:00 PM, where you'll meet the Marshall. The marshal will discuss the routes, rules, and regulations, and provide detailed instructions on riding in the Himalayas.
- Dinner and overnight stay in Manali.





DAY 3: MANALI to SARCHU

- Distance and travel time : 175km/approx. 6-7 hours.
- Terrain type : Intermediate.
- Begin the day with breakfast, followed by a ride towards Sarchu.
- Ride through the **Atal Tunnel**, a 9 km long tunnel, the world's longest highway tunnel above 10,000ft.
- En route visit the picturesque Lahaul Valley and cross key points including **Sissu**, **Keylong**, **Jispa** and **Darcha**.
- Cross **Baralacha Pass** (15,910 ft.), a stunning snow-covered route.
- Dinner and overnight stay in Sarchu.





DAY 4: SARCHU to LEH via TANGLANG LA PASS

- Travel distance and travel time (250 kms/ 7–8 hrs) approx.
- Terrain type (advance).
- Leh Altitude- 3500 meters. Crossing **22 Gata loops, Nakila pass, Lachulungla pass**, and More planes (Kiang Chu Thang) 45kms straight road.
- You need to cross **Tanglang la** pass (5328m/17480ft).
- It is the highest pass on Manali - Leh highway.
- Dinner and overnight stay in Leh.





DAY 5:

LEH to NUBRA via KHARDUNG LA PASS

- **Distance and travel time : 130km/approx. 5-6 hours.**
- Begin your day with satisfying breakfast at the hotel to prepare for an exciting off-roading adventure.
- Visit **Shanti Stupa** for blessing.
- Start a thrilling journey to Nubra Valley via **KHARDUNG LA PASS** (17,582ft.) one of the highest motor able roads in the world, offering breath taking views of snow-capped peaks.
- Upon arrival in Nubra Valley, visit **106 ft. tall Buddha Statue** at Diskit.
- Visit to the **sand dunes**, known as the cold deserts of India in Hunder, where you can opt for a camel safari and experience the refreshing desert breeze.
- Dinner and overnight stay at hotel in Hunder.



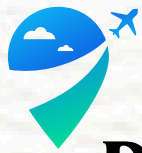


DAY 6:

NUBRA VALLEY to PANGONG LAKE via SHYOK

- **Distance and travel time : 170km/approx. 4-5 hours.**
- Rise and shine to savour a delicious breakfast and start your ride towards the renowned Pangong Lake via **Agyam** and **Shyok** villages.
- We'll ride to some of the toughest routes in Ladakh with off-roading and water crossings.
- Witness the stunning transformation of Asia's **Pangong Lake**, with its mesmerising colours shifts occurring 4-5 times a day.
- Admire its ever-changing shades of blue, reflecting the sunlight and the surrounding mountains of varying hues.
- Take in the panoramic views of Pangong Lake, nestled amidst the towering mountains of Ladakh.
- Dinner and overnight stay at Pangong lake at the elevation of 4300 meters.





DAY 7:

PANGONG to HANLE via REZANG LA

- Distance and travel time : 165km/approx. 5-6 hours.
- Leave Pangong Lake early in the morning after breakfast.
- Ride towards **Hanle**, a remote and scenic village known for its ancient monasteries and clear night skies.
- En-route, you'll cross the picturesque villages of **Chushul** and **Tsaga La**.
- Visit **REZANG LA WAR MEMORIAL**, a testimony to one of the most legendary battles in Indian military force history.
- Reach Hanle by afternoon.
- Spend the evening exploring Hanle village and visit the Hanle **Monastery**.
- Visit **Asia's Largest observatory** at Hanle.
- Dinner and overnight stay at HANLE.





DAY 8: HANLE - UMLING LA - NYOMA

- Distance and travel time : 200km/approx. 6-7 hours.
- Breakfast at the homestay, Begin your journey towards **UMLING LA (19,300ft.)**, World's Highest Motorable pass.
- Enjoy the scenic ride through the rugged terrain of Ladakh, reach UMLINGLA and take some time to soak in the breathtaking views.
- Take photographs and explore the surroundings.
- Descend back and head towards **NYOMA**.
- Reach Nyoma(a serene, **offbeat destination** known for the **700-year-old Nyoma Monastery**), checkin then visit Monastery.
- Dinner and overnight stay Nyoma.





DAY 9: NYOMA to LEH via TSO-MORIRI

- **Distance and travel time : 270km/approx. 8-9 hours.**
- Early morning departure from Nyoma, after breakfast.
- Drive to **Tso-Moriri Lake**(the world's highest Ramsar site), less crowded, offbeat, beautiful lake in Ladakh.
- After wards, visit **PUGA VALLEY** (A geothermal wonderland).
- Visit the **Chumathang Hot Springs**, famous for their therapeutic properties and start drive to Leh.
- Enroute visit **Rancho School** and **Thiksey Monastery**.
- Reach Leh by evening, allowing time to rest and explore the local markets.
- Dinner and overnight stay at Leh.





DAY 10: LEH to KARGIL

- **Distance and travel time : 220km/approx. 6-7 hours.**
- As soon as the morning unfolds today, embark on a scenic journey to Kargil.
- Along the way, visit the **Hall of Fame** museum, marvel at the **Magnetic Hill's** natural phenomenon, and stop by the revered **Pathar Sahib Gurdwara**.
- Continue your adventure to the Buddhist monastery of **Lamayuru**, perched at 3,510 m, followed by **Fotu La** mountain pass.
- Upon arrival in Kargil, checkin to hotel, enjoy dinner and relax with an overnight stay





DAY 11: Kargil to Srinagar

- Distance and travel time : 200km/approx. 7-8 hours.
- On your way to Srinagar enjoy numerous attractions like **Kargil War Memorial & Zojila Pass.**
- En route, enjoy the beauty of **Sonmarg** also known as Mini Switzerland of India.
- In the evening, on arrival deposit your bike keys with the road captain and enjoy an overnight stay in your pre-booked stay.
- Dinner, and Overnight Stay in Srinagar.

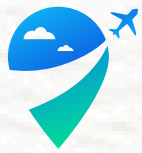

- The company is not liable for riders insurance (including injury or death) claims in the event of an accident. Riders are responsible for their own coverage.
- First-aid kits are supplied for minor injuries; however, in cases of medical emergencies or hospitalisation, riders are responsible for all associated expenses. The company will assist in providing immediate aid.
