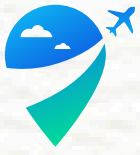

DAY 1: **LEH ARRIVAL and Acclimatisation**

- Arrive in KBR Airport Leh.
- Our cab driver will pick you up from the airport.
- Check-In into your accommodation.
- Take it easy to acclimatise to the high altitude.
- Evening, our team will meet you at the hotel to assign you gears and our Marshall will give you briefing about the trip.





DAY 2:

LEH to NUBRA via KHARDUNG LA PASS

- **Distance and travel time : 130km/approx. 5-6 hours.**
- Begin your day with satisfying breakfast at the hotel to prepare for an exciting off-roading adventure.
- Visit **Shanti Stupa** for blessing.
- Start a thrilling journey to Nubra Valley via **KHARDUNG LA PASS** (17,582ft.) one of the highest motor able roads in the world, offering breath taking views of snow-capped peaks.
- Upon arrival in Nubra Valley, visit **106 ft. tall Buddha Statue** at Diskit.
- Visit to the sand dunes, known as the cold deserts of India in Hunder, where you can opt for a camel safari and experience the refreshing desert breeze.
- Dinner and overnight stay at hotel in Hunder.





DAY 3: NUBRA - TURTUK - NUBRA

- Distance and travel time : 180km/approx. 5-6 hours.
- Wake up to a beautiful sunrise & get ready for the day.
- Today we will visit the charming village of **Turtuk**. Turtuk is a remote village that boasts of a unique identity inhabited by ethnic Muslims who have their own distinct traditions and culture.
- You can then explore this beautiful village surrounded by snow-clad mountains on your own. Here you can try out fruits like apricots and walnuts, for which this place is well known.
- Next, you can take selfies and click pictures on the wooden bridge along the banks of the **Shyok** River.
- Visit **THANG** village, last village on INDIA-PAKISTAN border.
- As the day comes to an end, return to Nubra Valley, where you can indulge in a delicious dinner.
- Overnight stay in hotel rooms in Hunder.





DAY 4:

NUBRA VALLEY to PANGONG LAKE via SHYOK

- Distance and travel time : 170km/approx. 4-5 hours.
- Rise and shine to savour a delicious breakfast and start your ride towards the renowned Pangong Lake via **Agyam** and **Shyok** villages.
- We'll ride to some of the toughest routes in Ladakh with off-roading and water crossings.
- Witness the stunning transformation of Asia's **Pangong Lake**, with its mesmerising colours shifts occurring 4-5 times a day.
- Admire its ever-changing shades of blue, reflecting the sunlight and the surrounding mountains of varying hues.
- Take in the panoramic views of Pangong Lake, nestled amidst the towering mountains of Ladakh.
- Dinner and overnight stay at Pangong lake at the elevation of 4300 meters.





DAY 5:

PANGONG to HANLE via REZANG LA

- Distance and travel time : 170km/approx. 5-6 hours.
- Leave Pangong Lake early in the morning after breakfast.
- Ride towards **Hanle**, a remote and scenic village known for its ancient monasteries and clear night skies.
- En-route, you'll cross the picturesque villages of **Chushul** and **Tsaga La**.
- Visit **REZANG LA WAR MEMORIAL**, a testimony to one of the most legendary battles in Indian military force history.
- Reach Hanle by late afternoon or early evening.
- Spend the evening exploring Hanle village and visit the Hanle **Monastery**.
- Dinner and overnight stay at HANLE.





DAY 6: HANLE - UMLING LA - NYOMA

- Distance and travel time : 200km/approx. 6-7 hours.
- Breakfast at the homestay, Begin your journey towards **UMLING LA (19,300ft.)**, World's Highest Motorable pass.
- Enjoy the scenic ride through the rugged terrain of Ladakh, reach UMLINGLA and take some time to soak in the breathtaking views.
- Take photographs and explore the surroundings.
- Descend back and head towards **NYOMA**.
- Reach Nyoma(a serene, **offbeat destination** known for the **700-year-old Nyoma Monastery**), checkin then visit Monastery.
- Dinner and overnight stay Nyoma.





DAY 7: NYOMA to LEH via TSO-MORIRI

- **Distance and travel time : 270km/approx. 8-9 hours.**
- Early morning departure from Nyoma, after breakfast.
- Drive to **Tso-Moriri Lake**(the world's highest Ramsar site), less crowded, offbeat, beautiful lake in Ladakh.
- After wards, visit **PUGA VALLEY** (A geothermal wonderland).
- Visit the **Chumathang Hot Springs**, famous for their therapeutic properties and start drive to Leh.
- Enroute visit **Rancho School** and **Thiksey Monastery**.
- Reach Leh by evening, allowing time to rest and explore the local markets.
- Dinner and overnight stay at Leh.

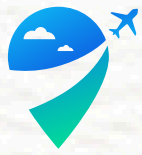




DAY 8: **DEPARTURE from LEH**

- Say goodbye to the beauty of Leh as you depart.





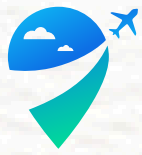
INCLUSION

- Riders will be responsible for covering the cost of any external damage to the motorbike or riding gear during the tour.
- Riding gear is provided by the company, available in sizes from S to 3XL (brand-dependent size variations may apply).
- The company is not liable for riders insurance (including injury or death) claims in the event of an accident. Riders are responsible for their own coverage.
- First-aid kits are supplied for minor injuries; however, in cases of medical emergencies or hospitalisation, riders are responsible for all associated expenses. The company will assist in providing immediate aid.
- In cases where travel dates are extended without prior notice, double the standard rental rate will apply for the additional days.
- If a rider abandons a motorbike during the tour, they will be responsible for the costs of returning the motorbike.
